What is the overall <a href="#">deductible</a> ?	\$0	See the Common Medical Events chart below for your costs for services this plan covers.
Are there services covered before you meet your <a href="#">deductible</a> ?	No.	This <a href="#">plan</a> covers items and services even if you haven't yet met the <a href="#">deductible</a> amount.
Are there other <a href="#">deductible</a> for specific services?	Yes. \$100 per person for <a href="#">prescription drugs</a> . There are no other <a href="#">deductibles</a> .
